As an affiliated group of the British Cardiovascular Society, the BACPR was first established as the British Association for Cardiac Rehabilitation (BACR) in 1993 as a multi-disciplinary body to represent and serve the interests of all professionals engaged in cardiac rehabilitation. To date it continues in this light with its membership consisting of a wide range of disciplines involved in cardiovascular disease prevention and rehabilitation- typically including cardiologists, GPs, nurses, physiotherapists, dieticians, psychologists, occupational therapists, exercise physiologists and exercise instructors. Members are from both primary care and the acute sectors together with individuals from leisure services and the fitness industry. The BACPR is governed by a Council elected from the membership, which is representative of the professions noted above and drawn from the four nations of the UK.
